# **INTRODUCTION**

On 24 October 2016, the General Director of General Statistic Office issued Decision No 719/QĐ-TCTK on the 2017 Labour force survey, along with its survey plan. The purpose of the survey was to collect the information on 2017 labor market participation from those people who are 15 years old and above currently residing in Vietnam; regarded as a basic for aggregating and compiling national statistical indicators on labor, employment, unemployment and income. These results would support for ministries and branches assessing and comparing the changes in labour market among quarters within the reference year as well as with those of previous annual labour force surveys conducted by GSO. These results would be also considered as a basic to develop and plan policies on human resource development; activities of investment, production and business accordant with the development trend on labor market; as well as to access and apply International Labor Organization's updated recommendations on labor and employment, especially in term of "labor under-utilization" into the reality of Vietnam. The statistics would be aggregated quarterly for the national and regional levels; and yearly for the provincial level.

This report would present major findings of labour force survey in quarter 3 , 2017 in order to provide information about labour market and employment for users. As a result of the survey coverage on labor market only relating to those people who were 15 years old, currently residing in Vietnam at the survey period, therefore, the indicators on labor and employment presented in this report would mainly be calculated for those persons aged 15 and above. However, due to the demand of researching, assessing and analyzing information about the labour market and employment situation for the working age group (including males aged from 15 to 59 and females aged from 15 to 54), the report would also provide some basic indicators on labor and employment for this group.

The 2017 Labor force survey has received technical supports of International Labor Organization (ILO). GSO highly appreciates these supports

and wishes to continuously receive more supports from ILO in succeeding surveys.

GSO hopes that this report will meet requirements of basic information for social economic policy markers, especially for those who are engaging into the field of labor and employment. We warmly welcome all constructive comments from readers.

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## I. SUMMARY

- As of Quarter 3, 2017 Vietnam has reached to **72** million persons aged 15 and above, of which 54.9 million people joined into the labour force (It is not included those people aged 15 and over who were currently not residing in Vietnam. Even the fact that the urbanization process has been going on, the rural labour force is continuously considered as dominant, currently accounting for 67,8% of total labour force).
- The labour force participation rate stood at **76.2%**. The considerable difference on labour force participation between urban and rural areas has remained, standing at **10** percentage points (**70.0%** against with **79.5%**). This participation rate of males was **81.1%**, and participation rate of females was 71.5%. The labour force participation rate of males and females decreased slightly as compared to that of Quarter 2 in 2017 (0.5 and 0.1 percent), However, the sex gap on labour force participation was decreased (10.0 percentage points in Quarter 2 compared to **9.6** percentage points in Quarter 3)
- As of Quarter 3, 2016 the labour force of whole country was constituted by 54.9 million employed labourers and more than 1.1 million unemployed labourers.
- The employment to population ratio of those people aged 15 and above was **74.6%**. The gap on this ratio between urban and rural still exists and is lower than previous quarter (1,2% points difference). In quarter 3, 2017, the employment to population ratio in urban areas reached to **67.9%**, with **10.4** percentage points lower than that of rural areas (78.3%).
- Based on number of working hours, at the whole country, there were 800.6 thousand underemployed labourers. The underemployed population was increased slightly as compared to that of Quarter 2 in 2017, nearly 17.1 thousand labourers. Of which, 84.1% of total underemployed population was currently residing in rural areas.
- In Quarter 3, 2017, the general unemployment rate increased dramatically as compared to Quarter 2 of 2017 (2,02 % versus 2,05 %). Accordingly, the unemployed population aged 15 and over only increased by 10.9 thousand labourers, as compared to previous quarter.
- The young unemployment rate (for those people aged from 15 to 24) was decreased, as compared to Quarter 2 of the same year (7.80% versus 7,67%). Number of unemployed youth accounted for 55.1% of total unemployed population. Of which, the urban share was found lower than that of rural areas (48.2% versus 61.3%). Meanwhile, the underemployed youth just accounted for one fifth (17.7%) of total underemployed population.

## II. MAJOR FINDINGS

### 1. Labour force

#### *1.1 Size and distribution of labour force and labour force participation rate*

As of Quarter 3, 2017, the labour force aged 15 and above in Vietnam reached to 54.9 million people. Despite of the increase on share for urban labour force, approximately 67.8% of the labour force in Vietnam has been residing in rural areas. Making a comparison among social economic regions, the Red River Delta and North Central and South Central Coast are the two areas with the largest labour market (21,7%), followed by the Mekong River Delta (18.9%). Thus, these three regions accounted for 62.3 % of total labour force. As of Quarter 3, 2017, females constituted about 48.1% (equivalent to 26.4 million persons) to total labour force.


At the national level, the labour force participation rate was **76.2%**. The considerable difference on labour force participation between urban and rural has

remained about 9.5 percentage points (70.0% against with 79.5%). The labour force participation rate for females stood at 71.5%, with 9.6 percentage points lower than that for males (81.1%). Notably, the highest labour force participation rates were for two mountainous regions, including Northern Midlands and Mountains (84.4%) and Central Highlands (84.2%). Meanwhile, the lowest ones belonged to two most developed social-economic centres of Vietnam, namely Hanoi and Hochiminh city (72.7% and 72.0%, respectively),

## 1.2 Age structure of labour force

The distribution of the labour force by age group reveals not only the context of demographic fact but also of social-economic situation. The labour force of Vietnam is considered as relatively young, with the considerable share of the 15-39 year old group (currently accounting for 49.9% of total labour force).

There was considerable difference in age structure of the labour force between urban and rural areas (as shown in Figure 1). The shares of youth (aged 15-24) and elderly (aged 55 and above) living in urban areas were found lower than those of rural areas. In contrast, the proportion of prime working age group (aged 25-54) in urban areas was higher than that of rural areas. This pattern could reflect the fact that the urban youth has joined into the labour market more later than the rural youth, due to their longer period of schooling. Meanwhile, the rural residents has joined earlier but stayed longer in the labour market, as a result of characteristics on rural jobs.

## 2. Employment

Table 2 shows the employment proportion and the employment-to-population ratio for those people aged 15+, classified by sex and 8 sampling domains (including 6 social-economic regions and 2 biggest cities) in Quarter 3 of 2017. Out of 54.9 million employed labourers, 68.1% (equivalent to 36.6 million persons) was residing in rural areas and 48.2% (equivalent to 25.9 million persons) was employed females. Making a comparison among social economic regions, the Red River Delta and the North and South Central Coast have currently occupied the largest relevant proportion, accounted for one half of total employed population; (22,7% and 21,0 % respectively), followed by the Mekong River Delta and the Southeast (18,8% and 17,1% respectively).

In details, as of Quarter 3, 2017, the employed population was estimated about 54.9 million people, increased by 26.6 thousand people as compared to Quarter 2, 2017.

Making a comparison among social economic regions, the changes in the number of employed population are quite different. In Quarter 3, Mekong River Delta had the most decrease of number of employed population (about 19 thousand peoples), while the most increase of number of employed population belonged to the North and South Central Coast (about 84 thousand peoples compared to Quarter 2).

The employed-to-population ratio for those who are 15 years old and above decreased by 0.3 percentage points. This ratio in Quarter 2 in 2017 has reached to **74,9%** while this ratio in Quarter 3 was **74,6%**. Urban-rural and sex gaps on this

ratio were nearly 10.4 and 9.3 percentage points, respectively. Comparing among social economic regions indicated that the highest employment-to-population ratios belonged to two mountainous regions, namely the Northern Midlands and Mountains and the Central Highlands (83.6% and 83.1 %, respectively), while two most developed social- economic centres, including Hanoi city and Hochiminh city occupied the lowest ones (71.3 % and 70.2%, respectively)



Figure 2 presents the proportion of employed population classified by industrial sector for each sampling domain. The data shows that the Southeast region, especially including Hochiminh city has the most advanced economic structure, with an increasing dominant proportion of industrial, constructional or service workers (about 85.1% of total ). Contrarily, for the mountainous and coastal areas, the proportion of employed labourers engaging into agriculture, forestry and fishery, has remained quite high. The Central Highlands has been regarded as the region occupying this largest proportion (about 72.0%), followed by the Northern Midlands and Mountains (62.9%).

### 3. Underemployment and unemployment


#### 3.1 Underemployed and unemployed labourers

As of Quarter 3, 2017, the labour force aged 15 and above was constituted by more than 800.6 thousand underemployed labourers and 1.11 million unemployed labourers. The underemployed labourers and unemployed labourers decreased as compared to Quarter 2, 2017 (17,1 and 10,0 thousand persons, respectively). The underemployment has been considered as more popular in rural areas. At present, about 81.5% of total underemployed population was residing in rural areas. Besides, the share of underemployed females was found higher than that of males (55.0% as compared to 45.0% of total underemployed population). On the other hand, the unemployment in urban areas should be concerned more even that the proportion of urban unemployed population was found lower, just accounting for 47.9% of total unemployed population. Moreover, the data of Quarter 3, 2016 also shows that unemployed males were more crowded than females (accounting for 53.6% versus 46.4% of total unemployed population).

Observing the unemployment by the technical/qualification attainment

reveals that in Quarter 3, 2017, nearly 58.6% of unemployed population have undergone technical/qualification training from 3 months or more. Among this group, those unemployed laborers, who have graduated from universities or above, occupied the largest share (about 21.7%).

Youth is considered as one labour group most vulnerable to the fluctuations in labour market. Thus, youth's unemployment has become important issue that should be paid attention in the society. In quarter 3, 2017 the unemployed youth aged from 15-24 accounted for 55.1% of total unemployed population throughout the country. Remarkably, the share of unemployed youth residing in urban areas was found lower than that of rural areas (accounting for 41.9% against with 58.1% of total unemployed population), as a result of more educational opportunities given by urban areas. In term of technical/qualification attainment, about 53.8% of total unemployed laborers who have undergone technical/qualification training from 3 months or more (equivalent to 247.4 thousand persons) were young ones. Of which, a dominant share (accounting for

75.1%) was formed by the young laborers who have graduated from college or above.

In addition, about 17.7% (equivalent to 141.5 thousand persons) of total 800.6 thousand under-employed workers throughout the country were young persons aged 15 - 24.

### **3.2 Underemployment rate and unemployment rate**

The working age underemployment and unemployment rates are referred to those females who are from 15 to 54 years old and those males who are from 15 to 59 years old.

As of quarter 3, 2017, the working age unemployment rate for the whole country reached to 1.87%. Of which, the urban unemployment rate (standing at 3.14%) was found higher than that of rural areas (1.77%). Sex gap on unemployment rate was not considerable, just 0.02% percentage points. However, among sampling domains, the unemployment rate was quite different. The region occupying the lowest rate was the Northern Midlands and Mountains (standing at 0.98%), equal to 2 times lower than that of whole country (2.23%); follow by the Central Highland (standing at 1.33%). The Mekong River Delta, the North and South Central Coast, the Southeast are three regions had the highest unemployment rate, respectively, 2.92%, 2.48% and 2.69%

The working age under-employment rate for the whole country decreased slightly in Quarter 3, 2017 as compared to Quarter 2, 2017 (1.54% versus 1.62%, respectively). The under-employment rate in rural areas stood at 1.87%, equal to nearly 2 times higher than that of urban areas (0.87%). Among regions, the Mekong River Delta has remained occupying the highest rate (about 3.23%), (equivalent to 2 times higher than that of whole country –standing at 1.54%).

At present, Vietnam's economy has met difficulties and this has affected the unemployment rate. Particularly, the working age unemployment rate has increased slightly from 2.26 % in Quarter 2, 2017 to 2.23% in Quarter 3, 2017. This could be explained in part by the fact that Vietnam is an agricultural country, characterized with the less developed economy, resulting to the people's low living standards and the insufficiently developed social security system. Therefore, people prefer involving into any kind of jobs, even into the informal ones giving unstable, low earnings and indecent working conditions, in order to support themselves and their families, rather than being into long-term unemployment to look for better jobs.

In Quarter 3, 2017, the unemployment rate of young group who have completed technical/qualification training from 3 months or more, stood at 16.3%, of which the unemployment for young females was higher than that rate of young males (18.3% versus 13.8%). However, there was a difference when comparing the unemployment between urban and rural (17. 0% against with 15. 6%). Notably, the youth's unemployment is likely increased along with their level of technical/qualification attainment, that is, more concerns on unemployment should be paid for those young people who have attained high technical/qualification level. For example, the unemployment rates of those young people who have graduated from college or university and above were found about 11.2% and 24.8%, respectively. Whereas this rate was much lower for those groups who have just completed "short-term vocational education" or "mid-term vocational/professional education (standing at 6.0 % and 14.4 %). The reason could be that those young people having high educational attainment (such as college, university or above) are often from 20 to 24 years old, have just graduated and lack of experiences. Therefore, they will meet difficult to find suitable jobs.
